



Bursary Information Sheet

At St Paul's British Primary School, we have a bursary policy which allows for a limited number of places to be made available at fees lower than our published fee structure. The policy relating to these bursaries is detailed below:

Eligibility

Any parent may apply for a bursary. Any bursary awarded is solely at the discretion of the management of the school, comprising Head Teacher, the Director of Admissions and the Bursar.

Criteria

The decision of whether to award a bursary is essentially a financial decision. We will look at the net household income (i.e. income from all sources but after deduction of tax and social security payments) and the commitment to pay school fees both to St Paul's BPS and other schools.

If a parent is entitled to equivalent free or subsidised education at another local school, it is unlikely that a bursary will be offered. If there are particular circumstances why a child should attend our school, this will be given due consideration.

Duration

We would hope that a bursary, once granted, is provided for the time a child remains a pupil at the school. This will however be reviewed annually and will be dependent upon any changes in family circumstances.

Level

The level of bursary offered depends on our evaluation of financial need. In the past this has varied between 5% and 30% of published fees.

Confidentiality

All communication on bursaries is in strict confidence between the family and the management of the school and families are requested not to reveal or discuss details with anyone.
